• SAFETY AND BEHAVIOUR:

Players are responsible for their safety while on the course and play at their own risk.

Players should ensure others are out of range before playing a shot.

Each player must have their own set of clubs and a golf bag. No sharing allowed. Hire equipment is available.

A maximum of four players are permitted in a group.

Maintain pace with the group ahead at all times. Course staff may ask players to join up groups to maintain the pace of play.

Appropriate attire is required. Thongs, high heels, and deep ripple-soled shoes are not permitted.

Please observe the rules and etiquette of golf to ensure a pleasant experience for everyone.

Always give way to green staff.

Show respect to others and staff. The City of Stirling and Stirling Leisure – Hamersley Public Golf Course hold zero Tolerance for swearing, threats, or any act of violence.

• LIABILITY:

The City of Stirling and Stirling Leisure – Hamersley Public Golf Course is not responsible for personal injuries or lost or damaged belongings.

Deliberate or irresponsible damage to property may result in the player being liable for costs associated to repair or replace.

• NO SMOKING OR BYO:

No smoking or vaping anywhere on the driving range, golf course or club house premises. BYO alcohol is not permitted. Beverages can only be purchased through licensed venue onsite.

• AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Children 12 years and under must be supervised by an adult at all times.

• CLEANLINESS:

Dispose of trash properly.

Take all personal items with you.

• WEATHER POLICY:

The golf course may close due to bad weather; check in advance for updates.

• REPORT ISSUES:

Players are to report breaches of rules to course staff.

Any breaching of the conditions of play may be asked to leave the premises.

• IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:

Call 000 if life threatening.
